2m Frequency Change on W6XSC-1

On Wednesday, March 23rd, the 2 meter access frequency will change from 144.910 MHz to 144.990 MHz. This will complete the planned frequency changes for the Santa Clara County network as presented approximately one year ago.

Action Items

On or shortly after Wednesday, March 23rd, we recommend the following actions:

1. Print and retain a copy of the updated frequency and BBS info web page: <http://www.scc-ares-races.org/fregs/packet-fregs.html>
2. Reprogram the memory of your radio(s) to save the new frequency.
3. In Outpost, go to: Setup > BBS. Select "SCC BBS 1 – SCCO OFFICES SAN JOSE". Update the description field to reflect the change. Note that the description already contains a notice about the frequency change. Updating the description will provide you with a handy reminder of the new frequency when using Outpost.
