INSTRUCTIONS FOR USING THE SCC VHF/UHF CONTEST LOG FORM

- 1. Your Name: Enter you name.
- 2. Your Call Sign: Enter your FCC Call Sign.
- 3. **Your City Identifier**: Enter the three-letter identifier assigned to your city/agency. I.E. San Jose SJC, Mountain View MTV, Campbell CBL, etc. See Appendix B of the Rules for the valid identifiers.
- 4. **Time**: Record the 24-Hour local time for each contact made.
- 5. **Repeater Call Sign:** Record the call sign of the repeater used to make the contact.
- 6. **Call Sign of Contact**: Record the FCC Call Sign of each station (contact) worked. This is NOT the Repeaters call sign.
- 7. **3-letter ID of Contact:** Record the 3-letter identifier that the station you worked reported.
- 8. **Points**: Enter the points earned for each contact: 1 point for contacts using your same city code, 3 points for contacts with other cities or agencies and 5 points for those assigned to use the XSC code.
- 9. **Points This Page:** Add the points earned on this page.
- 10. **Using an HT:** If using an HT with a directly connected antenna (not external), double the points on line 9 and enter here. If not using an HT enter the value from line 9 here.
- 11. **Total Points from prior page:** Enter the TOTAL POINTS from the prior page if this is not Page 1.
- 12. **TOTAL POINTS:** Add lines 10 and 11 and enter here. This number will be carried over to line 11 on the next page.

Exchange Format: Other Stations Call Sign, Your City Identifier, Your Call Sign

If part of the exchange was missed or incorrect, ask for a fill/clarification of the missing information.

Log only contacts where both parties have a complete and accurate copy of the exchange.

Only legible logs will be counted for scoring.
